

NatWest Student Offer Terms

Who's eligible for the offer?

New and existing National Westminster Bank Plc ('NatWest') customers who are eligible to open a Student account. This means you need to have spent more than three years in the UK and be at a UK university/college:

- · completing a full-time undergraduate course lasting at least two years; or
- · completing a full-time postgraduate course; or
- · training as a nurse

You won't be eligible for the offer if:

· You have received a Student offer from NatWest at any time from 1st July 2020.

You must:

 open a new NatWest Student account or change your existing current account to a NatWest Student account, via natwest.com or on our mobile app, between 15th July 2024 and the date this offer is withdrawn.

What is the offer?

If you meet the conditions set out above, you'll get £100 cash and a tastecard which is valid for 4 years from the date your welcome email is sent to you.

What happens next?

Once your account is opened and if you meet all the conditions, we'll:

- pay £100 into your Student account within 10 working days. We won't pay £100 if the new Student account is closed, even if you've met all required conditions; and
- send you a tastecard redemption code to the email address you gave us at account opening within 5 days.

Withdrawal of offer

We may withdraw, change or replace this offer at any time without notice. If we withdraw the offer and you have already applied for a new Student account, you will still be entitled to receive this offer provided that you have met the conditions set out in these terms.

What else do I need to know?

- You can only benefit from this offer once. This means, that even if you successfully open more than one Student account and meet the conditions of this offer, you'll only receive one payment and one tastecard redemption code.
- You'll still be bound by Your Current Account Terms, which contain everything applicable to your student
 account, including any regular criteria you need to meet to keep your account.
